

Information clause on the processing of personal data in the Uważna Pracownia Terapii

1. Pursuant to the provisions of the Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons and in connection with the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and the repeal of Directive 95/46 / EC, hereinafter referred to as the GDPR, as well as the Act of May 10, 2018 on the protection of personal data (Journal of Laws of 2018, item 1000), I inform you that:
2. The administrator of your personal data is Uważna Pracownia Terapii Kamila Fryc with its registered office in Poznań at ul. Śniadeckich 28/2, NIP: 777 291 26 15, REGON: 361267083. 3. The administrator obtained your personal data from CGP Europe Kft, Hungary, Ady Endre utca 19 1024, KRS: 0000689506, NIP: HU23425026.
4. The basis for the processing of your personal data is the performance of the contract concluded with CGP Europe Kft for the provision of psychological advice under the EAP: "Employee assistance program" - a psychological, legal or financial advisory service provided to the client's employees and is necessary to fulfill legally justified goals pursued by the Administrator.
5. Your personal data is processed manually and electronically for the purpose of the performance of the contract between Uważna Pracownia Terapii and CGP Europe Kft.
6. The Administrator processes your personal data in a strictly defined, minimum scope, necessary for the purposes mentioned above.
7. The data provided by you will not be profiled or processed automatically.
8. The administrator will not transfer personal data outside the European Economic Area.
9. The recipient of your personal data is specialists providing services for you.
10. Providing personal data is voluntary, but necessary for the performance of the service.
11. Your personal data will be processed for the period necessary to achieve the purposes of processing.
12. You have the right to request the Administrator to access your personal data, rectify it and the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Data Protection Office (00-193 Warsaw, Stawki 2), if you believe that the Administrator is processing your data inconsistently with the General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679 or the Personal Data Protection Act of May 10, 2018. In order to exercise the above rights, please contact the Administrator of your data in one of the ways indicated in point 1.
